



Omply Health ISO27001:2022 Certification

Our partner company, 73Health Oy, has achieved ISO 27001:2022 certification, an internationally recognised standard for information security management systems. The certification covers the company's processes, security controls, governance practices, and operational procedures, and obtaining it requires a thorough assessment by an external auditor.

This demonstrates that the organisation has a clear and effective framework for risk management, security policies, technical and organisational safeguards, and continuous monitoring and improvement.

Because Omply and 73Health share the same ownership structure, the same experts, and largely the same technology and service platform, the ISO 27001:2022 certification directly affects Omply's operations. Omply's technical and operational processes are built upon the same information security architecture on which the certification is based.

In practice, this means that Omply's service development, data processing, risk management, and customer-environment procedures operate within the same certified security framework validated through 73Health.

This provides Omply with two concrete advantages. First, the company can utilise ready-made and audited security structures, which accelerates scaling and international expansion — areas where information security requirements are particularly strict.

Second, the certification demonstrates to investors and partners that the infrastructure behind the company's services already meets international-level information security requirements.

From Omply's perspective, this is a significant qualitative strength. The service has been built in an environment where security, continuous monitoring, and risk management are an integral part of daily operations — not an afterthought or an add-on.

This creates a strong foundation for Omply's own certification and sends a clear message to customers and investors that the company is built from the outset according to stringent standards. Omply will seek ISO 27001:2022 certification as part of its Growth Plan, as it is effectively mandatory for high-volume operations in international healthcare markets.
